Am I a "Booster/Representative of Athletics Interests?"

You are a Representative/Booster of Marist College's Athletic Interests if:

- You have ever participated in or been a member of the Red Fox Club or any other groups, which support specific athletic teams.
- You are or have ever been an employee of Marist College.
- You have ever contributed to the Marist athletic program or Athletic Scholarship Fund.
- You have ever assisted in providing benefits to an enrolled student-athlete or his or her family or friends.
- You have ever helped to arrange or have provided summer or semester break employment for an enrolled student-athlete.
- You have ever helped to arrange or have provided summer employment to prospects who have signed an offer of admission to Marist College.
- You have ever purchased season tickets for any of Marist's athletics programs.
- You have ever promoted the Marist athletic program.
- You have ever been involved with the Marist athletic program in any capacity.
- You are the spouse of a Marist College athletics department employee.
- You have ever contacted (by letter, telephone, or in person) a high school student, grades 9-12, for the purpose of encouraging the student to participate in the athletics program of Marist College.

NCAA rules state that once an individual has been identified as such a representative, the individual retains that identity for life. Marist is then ultimately responsible for the acts of all representatives in relation to NCAA rules and regulations.
